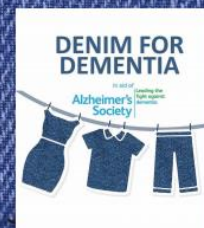

### KS2 Residentials

As you might know we have a planned set of experiences for Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6 pupils. Whilst we take every care to ensure that the costs are minimised, things such as trips are just getting more and more expensive. For example the price of the Y6 residential for next year will go up by at least £10.

In order to allow as many pupils to have access to these trips we organise a savings scheme. You can save year round for these and build up your savings for the next planned trip. Approximate costs for trips are Y6 £160, Y5 to Malham £100, Y4 camp £30, Y3 sleepover £10.

We appreciate this is quite a commitment for families. So if you want to start saving now, please see Mrs Shaw in the school office.
