We have all had another busy week in Nursery! There's been a lot of baking going on in the playdough area, witch role-play, lots of writing (so many children are enjoying the cursive script challenge!) and some lovely play in the water area experimenting with the measuring cylinders and making tea. The children have been so well behaved during their group times and are focusing really well during these sessions. We have been talking about the 'settings' of stories so if you could talk about where the story is set when reading with your child it will really help them to consolidate their understanding of this.

Phonics

We are still practising all the alphabet sounds and pictures that we have been learning throughout the year. Our song of the week next week will be 'Head, shoulders, knees and toes'.

The shape of the week next week will be star and our number of the week will be 5 (short neck, tummy fat, number 5 wears a hat! We put on our hat with 5 fingers—this is a good way to remember!).
