The enthusiasm of our 'exercises' has been brilliant to see and the children's stamina seems to be really building up (and the adults' too!).

Phonics

This week we practised 'z' again as well as thinking about all the sounds that we have learned. We are really practising 'initial sounds' at the moment so when we think of an object we say the name of it slowly to emphasise the first sound. We have to be really careful when we are pronouncing the sound so that we say it carefully without adding an 'uh', for example, saying 'ssssssss' rather than 'suh'. This makes it much easier for children to join sounds together and hear words. Our song of the week next week will be 'Hickory Dickory Dock'.

Maths

The shape of the week this week is star and the shape of the week next week will be square, our number of the week will still be 5 – Please send some objects in to share with the class during our maths sessions! You could listen to the YouTube 'Shapes song' that we listen to at school too.


