This week's learning

We have been doing lots of counting and talking about shapes as well as comparing the different settings of stories (e.g. under the sea, the woods, farm) and talking about the characters in stories. We have continued to practise our skills of rhyming and hearing the sounds in words this week. Remember to look at YouTube—jolly songs for the 'sound songs' that we sing in school. (Qu is on a different clip so you will need to search for it separately). Our rhyme of the week next week will be 'The sun has got his hat on'.

Home learning

Over the holidays please keep practising counting 10 objects slowly and carefully, recognising numbers, rhyming (read lots of rhyming stories and sing songs!, saying the sound that words begin with (you could play eye spy), 'sounding words out', listening for sounds around you and you could even visit the library!
