We have had another good week, learning about farm animals and their babies. The children also practised their balancing skills in PE and used them in team games. They have also been busy making cards for a special person for a special day at the weekend. 😊

On Wednesday, the children also attended a road safety assembly and did a walk around the field to spend time thinking about walking and road safety. Please ask your child to tell you how they are going to keep safe on the roads.

In Maths we have continued to build on our understanding of numbers to 20. The children have counted accurately and matched the numeral and Numicon to the amount they counted. They also had to explain true/false questions such as, "Is this 14?" "Why do you think that?"

In phonics this week most children have been reading 2-syllable words such as farmyard, sheepdog and rooftop. They have also learnt to read words with consonant, consonant, vowel, consonant letters. E.G. spin, stop, swim, stick, speck. The children have also learnt the tricky word 'so'. All children have continued to practise their reading and writing skills.
