This week we have been learning about the story 'Supertato'. The children have enjoyed drawing and writing about the characters, making peg superheroes and doing superhero role play with their friends. We will continue with the superhero theme next week.

In Maths this week we have been learning to share amounts fairly. They have shared 'cookies' with 2 and 3 people and have worked out what to do if they had an odd number, such as 7 or 9. "I gave three to them and three to them, and there is a spare one. Otherwise it is not fair." The children have also been ordering groups of numerals, for example, 4, 9, 2.

In phonics we have learnt the trigraph (three letters, one sound) ear (hear, fear, beard, near). The children have read words and sentences containing ear words and have written sentences using this phoneme. We have also been practising reading all the tricky words we have learnt.

PE

This week we had an unexpected PE lesson on Monday afternoon, taught by one of the teachers from the Leeds Rhinos Federation. The children moved in different ways to warm up, then practised their ball control skills and applied them in a game at the end. PE will be on Monday afternoons, with Mr Lawson and the class teachers, for the rest of this half term.
