We have started to learn about the farm and farm animals this week, in preparation for our visit to Hesketh Farm.

For our trip, **the children will need:**

- **A sun hat and sun cream** (applied before the trip)
- **A jacket or coat** (it can get quite windy at the farm as it is in a valley)
- **A packed lunch** in a named plastic bag (if they are not having a school packed lunch). We can then dispose of this at the farm.
- **A drink** in a named bottle (no fizzy drinks please)

All children will need to wear their **uniform** and suitable shoes for walking around the paddock and for using the play equipment. We will leave at 9.15 and we will be back before the end of the school day. Please drop off/collect as usual from the classroom doors. If your child needs travel sickness medication, please give it as required before the trip and send the second dose in a labelled envelope. Please give to the class teacher.

In Maths we have been subtracting single digit numbers. The children have created their own number problems. For example, **FIRST** there were 10 sheep in the field. **THEN** 2 ran away. **NOW** there are 8 sheep in the field.

In phonics this week we have been practising reading oa and ar words and sentences. We have practised reading tricky words and 'high frequency' (common) words.

PE will return to Thursdays after the half term.

Thank you for all of you who could come to Stay and Play. It was a lovely opportunity for the children to share their learning with you. Next half term there is no stay and play. Instead, we are having a celebration event at Swinnow Park. The date and details to follow.
