This week in Reception we have begun to learn about farm animals. When we go on the trip next week the children will get the opportunity to make milk and feed the lambs/calves, collect eggs, stroke some animals and have a tractor trailer ride. In phonics this week, Miss Horner and Mrs Houghton's group have started to read CVCC words (with two consonants at the end), such as lost, tent, band, pong, toast etc. They have also learnt the tricky words said and so. Miss Millington's group have learnt the trigraph ure (pure, cure, sure, insure, manure). Mrs Jones' group have been practising ch, sh and th. All children have been practising their reading and writing skills.

In maths this week we have been counting back by singing counting songs, such as 10 woolly sheep, sitting in a pen (to the tune of 'ten green bottles'). We have also been writing teen numbers and making them with Numicon pieces.

Next week we will continue to learn about farm animals and we will do activities around our visit to the farm.
