Week 1 (statutory list)

accidentally, actually, address, answer, appear, arrive, believe, bicycle, breath, breathe

Grammar: word classes - types of nouns.

Week 2 test (ure)

measure, treasure, pleasure, enclosure, pressure, capture, brochure, fracture, texture, fissure etc.

Grammar: conjunctions and complex sentences.

Week 3 test (statutory)

weight, various, through, although, therefore, surprise, suppose, strength, strange, straight.

Grammar: Use of the present perfect form of verbs instead of the simple past (e.g. He has gone out to play contrasted with: He went out to play).

Week 4 test (homophones)

peace/piece, main/mane, fair/fare, morning/mourning, great/gate, eyes/ice, inn/in, there, their, they're, were, where, we're, etc.

Grammar: Possessive apostrophe with singular proper nouns e.g. Cyprus's population.

Week 5 test (homophones)

there, their, they're, were, where, we're, you, yew, ewe, too, two, to, be/bee, see/sea, might/mite, place/plaice, etc.

Grammar: types of adjectives - comparative, superlative. E.g. big, bigger, biggest. Good, better, best, etc.

Week 6 test

Test of words learnt so far - random selection.

Grammar: punctuating direct speech - e.g. "I love skipping!" exclaimed Sarah.
