Week 1 re-test of last term's spellings.

Grammar: Homophones re-cap and test.

Week 2 test (statutory)

Grammar: Test of apostrophes for possession and contraction. E.g. Tuesday's lesson, can't, don't etc.

Week 3 test (Prefixes -ir, inter-, anti)

Investigation of prefixes - class competition - how many can you find?

irrational, irregular, irritable, irresponsible, irreverent, irreplaceable, anticlockwise, antiseptic, antibody, antipodes, international, interject, interlude, intervene.

Grammar: Changing word classes of words using prefixes and suffixes - e.g. child - childish, like - likeable, work - worker, taste - tasteless etc.

Week 4 test (statutory)

potato(es), pressure, probably, promise, purpose, quarter, eighth, question, recent, regular, reign.

Grammar: Test of plurals - e.g. baby/babies, lady/ladies, sheep, reindeer etc - can you find any interesting plurals?

Week 5 test (suffixes - cian, -sion, -tion, -ssion,)

magician, politician, optician, beautician, attraction, occasion, provision, direction, reduction, confusion, television, decision, pollution, corrosion, electrician, procession, collision.

Grammar - their, there, they're, your, you're and common errors.

Week 6 test (statutory)

remember, sentence, separate, grammar, special, straight, strange, strength, suppose, surprise, therefore.

Grammar: Test of punctuating speech - e.g. "Hello."
