Week 1 (ough)

Including: although, bough, though, cough, rough, rough, tough, enough, dough, drought, thorough, thought, trough, plough, brought, wrought, sought.

Grammar: determiners - determiners are used with nouns to clarify the noun

- articles: a, an, the.
- demonstratives: this, that, their, his, hers, whose, my friend's etc.
- quantifiers: few, a few, many, each, some, any etc.
- numbers: one, two, three etc.
- ordinals: first, second, third etc.

Week 2 test (ough)

As per week 1 - re-cap of words the class are finding hard, re-cap of determiner if needed.

Grammar: Correctly punctuated direct speech. E.g. "I love grammar!" said Sarah.

Week 3 test (silent letter words)

lamb, knight, island, solemn, autumn, Wednesday, thistle, government, environment, guarantee, stomach, vehicle, temperature, twelfth, marvellous, neighbour, rhyme.

Grammar: Writing complex sentences using the words taught so far - refer back to year 3 and 4 spellings.

Week 4 test (ble)

Adorable/adorably adoration, application, applicable/applicably, changeable, noticeable, dependable, comfortable understandable, enjoyable, reliable, possible, responsible etc.

Grammar: Determiners - see above, include direct speech and complex sentences.

Week 5 test (homophones)

Test of homophones to include: isle/aisle, aloud/allowed, affect/effect, herd/heard, past/passed.

Grammar: Word classes - adjectives comparative, superlative - e.g. big, bigger, biggest.

Week 6 test (able)

miserable, probable, adorable, respectable, forgivable, disposable, agreeable, enviable, identifiable, valuable, breakable, reliable etc.

Grammar: Word classes - types of nouns.

Week 7

Test of words learnt so far - random selection. Grammar: Re-cap of grammar learnt so far.
