



## **Sport Premium: £9405 (Projected Budget for 2014-15; £8000 + £5 per pupil)**

### **Benefits:**

- Sustained access to inter-school competitions and sporting events; Boys football performed at their best level for many years in recent inter school competitions, and at a city wide level reached the knock-out stages of a tournament.
- Improved opportunities for children to engage in sporting experiences and promote engagement in out of school sports leading to improved chances of lifelong participation.
- Progressive teaching of PE skills through whole school CPD (REAL P.E. programme and resources).
- Confident and good teaching of PE as a result of renewed focus on fundamental skills and developing a challenging and Growth Mindset within PE lessons.
- Effective liaison with local providers, local teams and sports opportunities to ensure our children benefit from the sporting community.
- Excellent professional development for subject leader - Access to LEA CPD: increasing the school's engagement in local and national initiatives that benefit our participation and outcomes for children.
- Active engagement with Leeds Rhinos as part of a traded services agreement which provides 48 hours of delivery split between: curriculum and extra curriculum coaching, 'healthy lifestyles' and 'winning team' assemblies, fundraising days, 'day to remember' stadium/ match day access.
- Promotion of active lifestyle choices through activities such as Skipping School day.
- Good CPD for staff through Leeds United Football Club curriculum sessions, and excellent experiences for children through extra-curricular clubs.

## **USE OF FUNDING**

### **£1000 - Active Schools City Wide PE partnership**

- We have a lead person to communicate with.
- Support in raising standards of achievement across the school, improving the quality of teaching and learning in PE, enhancing leadership of PE in schools and across clusters of schools.
- Promoting effective sport and healthy lifestyles, benchmarking our provision and outcomes nationally in PE, physical activity and school sport with the opportunity to share practice and learn from the best schools in Leeds and Nationally.
- Increased capacity for inter school competitions, festivals, participation and celebration events
- Membership of the Youth Sport Trust at a discounted rate – including resources and an audit of our provision.
- Leeds School Sport Association membership.
- Preferential access to deals brokered with professional clubs and key partners.
- A national PE professional development programme accessible to us.

### **£1,500 – Pudsey Cluster partnership – local partnership which ensures:**

- PE leaders work together across schools – work with PLTs to deliver PE and sport premium outcomes appropriate to each school by sharing planning, schemes of work and specialist training.
- CPD programme designed by PLT, partnership staff and accessing city and youth sport trust offer. Use of local secondary PE teachers to provide specialist CPD during curriculum led sessions; this year this will focus on OAA (outdoor and adventurous activity) challenges for KS2 to meet Curriculum requirements.
- Competition calendar for Pudsey, which feeds into the city competition pathway.
- Access to high school facilities and local sporting clubs.

**£1900 - Leeds Rhino's traded services agreement**

- Assigned contact through the agreement for 48 hours of contact time to deliver curriculum led coaching across the school at an appropriate level; multi skills up to rugby led activities. To also include extra-curricular clubs and assemblies.
- Link activities into festivals/competitions– The active school offer or other activities provided lead into inter-school games (multi-sports) with competitions between the schools or in the school as the end product.
- Link into Community Clubs – Exit strategy into local existing infrastructures at the end of a term (Rugby League club taster sessions)
- Additional activities– Player appearances, Ronnie Rhino appearance, attendance at School Fairs and celebrations.
- School benefits such as Day to Remember/Group Trips–Promotion of school offers where the children are invited to attend a Leeds Rhinos game and take part in some activity at that event.

**£1710 – REAL P.E. resources and whole school training day**

- Purchase of K.S. 1 and K.S. 2 planning resources, posters, DVD's and whole school training day, delivered by a National trainer.

**£350 – Skipping School**

- Provision of a days delivery to the whole school from reception to Year 6 introducing skipping skills at an age appropriate level. In keeping with current Park Spring PE philosophy, fundamental skills were taught and developed at a challenging pace. This led to a celebration assembly for the whole school. Interest in skipping within school increased dramatically and close to 100 skipping ropes were sold to staff and pupils, leading to increased safe activity at playtimes, and more active lifestyles at home. The follow on Charity event also raised over £1000 for school funds and further raised the profile of skipping within school. There is now a skipping club once a week, and many children can still be found skipping at breaktimes.
