## Parking Offences Around School

There are a large number of people stopping to drop off children within the markings of the zebra crossing. This puts all our children at risk, and is a traffic offence. Please do not stop to drop off on the crossing markings.

Penalty charge Notice fines for parking, stopping or dropping off on white zig zag lines is in the higher region of £70 but is reduced by 50% if paid within the times displayed on the ticket. White zig zag road markings are enforced 24 hours a day, each day of the year and do not need a sign to enforce the no parking prohibition.

Parking prohibition is enforced by local councils who issue a PCN and the police who will issue an endorsable Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) and will incur 3 penalty points on the offenders licence.
