We have been thinking about the story 'Mr Gumpy's Outing' this week, in relation to our topic about transport. We read the story, used a small world area to retell the story and we completed a word study about one of the words in the book - trampled. The children have learnt what this word means and have used it in a sentence. "The boy trampled on the ant." "She trampled on my bag." Next week our word of the week will be 'travel'. Please talk to your child about this word and talk to them about any travelling they have done. We will also be continuing to look at different types of transport next week.

In maths we have been learning about the number 14. "Fourteen is one ten and four ones." "Fourteen is fourteen ones." "One more than fourteen is fifteen." "One less than fourteen is thirteen."

Next week we will be focussing on ordering numbers to 15, and saying the number that is one less.

In phonics we have learnt the digraphs oo (boot, moon, tooth), oa (goat, boat, road, coat) and oo (book, look, shook, foot) and the tricky word you. We have practised reading and writing words and sentences containing these digraphs. We have begun to join the letters together, but do not worry if your child cannot do this yet. They will when they are ready.
