Another said, "Three fives are fifteen." We have seen some great maths learning recently!

In phonics we have learnt the digraph or (for, port, fork, port, torn) and the tricky word all. We have practised reading and writing words and sentences containing these digraphs.

After the holidays we will be starting a topic about homes, linking in to the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. We will look at different types of homes as we walk up to church for the Easter service.
