It has been another short but busy week again, with lots of super learning. We have had a bit of a Minecraft craze using the multilink cubes. Tom made a block. "It's a cube!" he said. Great maths vocabulary! We have also been retelling the story of 'The Three Little Pigs', using actions and words from the story. "Little pig, little pig, let me come in!" "No no no! Not by the hairs on my chinny chin chin!" "Then I'll huff and I'll puff and I will blow your house down!"

Thank you to the people who helped with the church visit. The children enjoyed the trip and were very well behaved.

In maths this week we have recapped number 16. "Sixteen is sixteen ones." "Sixteen is one ten and six ones." "One more than sixteen is seventeen." "One less than sixteen is fifteen." We have sorted amounts into two groups: 16 and not 16, by counting the pictures.

In phonics we have learnt the trigraph ear (fear, ear, dear, near) and the tricky word all. We have recapped all the other tricky words and phonemes taught so far. We have practised reading and writing words and sentences containing these phonemes in.

On Thursdays from the 2nd May we are inviting you to stay with your child for 10 minutes at the beginning of the day to share a book with them in class. It is called 'Roll Up and Read' and will take place every Thursday at 8.50 - 9.00. We want to develop a love of reading and sharing books together is a great way to do this.
