This week we have been retelling and writing about the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. We have read the text together, filling in the missing words. Next week will be our final week of this topic.

It was lovely to see the love of reading being shared at 'Roll Up and Read!' This will happen every Thursday morning at 8.50 -9.00. We noticed it encouraged some children to have a go at reading their book by themselves. This is what we hoped would happen! Thank you.

In maths this week we have learnt about number 17. "Seventeen is seventeen ones. Seventeen is one ten and seven ones". "One more than seventeen is eighteen. One less than seventeen is sixteen". We have also been naming different coins to 50p. We have talked about what they are like and we have done a shop role play to practise using the coins and talking about them. Next week we will be exploring pattern.

In phonics we have learnt the digraphs oi (coin, oil, foil, tinfoil, boil, join) and ow (cow, now, down, town, how, pow!). We have read common high frequency words. We have practised spelling the tricky words the, to, I, no, go by making our own bingo games. Next week we will learn the trigraph 'air' and the digraph 'er'.

Our word of the week has been 'coin'. Next week our word will be 'pattern'.
