In maths this week we have recapped number 17 and have explored pattern. The children have created their own patterns, including making pictures with shapes and making repeating patterns such as red, green, red, green, red, green and boy boy, girl girl, boy boy, girl girl.

In phonics we have learnt the trigraph air (chair, fair, lair, hair) and the digraph er (hammer, ladder, boxer, letter). We have practised reading common high frequency words and tricky words. We have also practised our spelling and writing skills.

Our word of the week has been 'pattern'. Next week our word will be 'beat' (linking to music).
