We have had a lovely week finding out about animals and their babies. Our book of the week has been 'Monkey Puzzle', which follows a monkey looking for its Mummy with a butterfly and finds other animals along the way. We have also looked at the lifecycle of a butterfly. Next week our book of the week is 'Dear Zoo'. We will be moving on to learn more about animals from around the world.

In maths we have been practising subtraction and solving subtraction problems. For example, "First there were seven sheep in a field. Then, three snuck through the fence. Now there are four sheep left." We have also been reading numbers and practising addition facts.

In phonics we have been reading words with two consonants at the beginning, like swim, spot, stop, spin. We have also learnt the new tricky word so.
