The children have had fun this week learning the actions to, and retelling the story of, The Little Red Hen. We loved their enthusiasm! Next week we are going to introduce the story of 'Handa's Surprise', which links into 'Black History Week' across the school. We will be looking at a range of inspirational black people across the week.

The new phonemes we have learnt this week are m and d. We have practised reading words such as mad, dim, mat, sad and and. We have also learnt the tricky words 'to' and 'no'. See if your child can find them in story books at home.

In maths we have been developing our understanding of the number 2. The children have found two objects, written the number 2 and have learnt what is one more and one less than 2. "One more than two is three; one less than two is one." Next week we will be learning about the number three, and triangles, as this links to 3.

This weekend we have sent home a 'Book Bear' with a book in a bag. Each child will get the opportunity to borrow one of Miss Horner's or Mrs Houghton's special books and take it home to tell the Book Bear about it.
