Wow! What an amazing first half term we have had! We are so proud of all the children and how well they have settled into Reception life. Thank you to all our families for supporting us and the children. We hope that you have an enjoyable and restful half term.

The new phoneme we have learnt this week is k. We have practised reading words such as kit and kip. We have practised all our new tricky words. Please continue to practise reading these words over the holidays: the, to, I, no, go.

In maths we have been developing our understanding of the number 3. The children have counted three objects and have practised writing the numeral 3 - "a curl for you, a curl for me, that's the way to write a three." The rhymes for writing numbers 0, 1 and 2 are:
"Start at the top and round you go, that's the way to write zero."
"Start at the top and down you run, that's the way to write a one."
"Candy cane, give it a shoe, that's the way to write a two."

Thank you to everyone who attended the family consultations sessions or met with us afterwards.

It was lovely to have our first 'Stay and Play' sessions this week. Thank you if you were able to attend. We hope you were able to see the breadth of activities the children have been accessing and that you had fun playing with them!

Roll up and read will continue after the holidays, each Thursday morning.

On Tuesday 5th November we will be having an 'Awesome Autumn' day where we do lots of our learning outside. This will link to Autumn and bonfire night.
