Dear Parents/Carers

As you will know, we have been using Parent Pay for some time now and it was our aim to eventually become a 'cashless' school.

As such, from the new Term in January, all trips, visits, lunches, Breakfast and After School Clubs, after school activity clubs and Nursery extra hours will all be payable via Parent Pay.

Places for **all** after school activity clubs (i.e. football etc.), both chargeable and non-chargeable, will now only be able to be booked via Parent Pay. These bookings will act as your permission for your child(ren) to attend and will be on a first come first served basis – as before.
