November Numeracy Challenge 15-21November2021

Your child's school has entered in the **November Numeracy Challenge**. This is a global mathematics challenge focused on using Live Mathletics. Students take part in 60-second races that test the speed and accuracy of their mathematics fluency skills. Prizes are awarded for top performing schools.

There is also a free Mathletics app for tablet devices that students can use to access Mathletics from anywhere. All of their activities are recorded and will be synced with their main Mathletics account.
