




School Uniform and PE Uniform

Parking Issues Around School

We have been contacted by residents who live near to school who are disgruntled about irresponsible and unsafe parking in the area, especially at drop off and pick up times. This includes parking on double yellow lines, on the zigzags by the zebra crossing, double parking, blocking access for residents to enter their property and mounting pavements excessively



On inspection over the last week and with photographic evidence we are inclined to agree with the residents that the parking does pose a risk to residents, pupils and members of the public.

We have contacted our Neighbourhood Policing Team and our local councillors for advice and assistance in addressing this very serious matter.

We must ask all of our families to park responsibly. We understand the weather is not always fantastic so, however, in order to keep us all safe you may need to park a little further up the road.

In addition please note that during the hours of 8.45am to 9.15am and 3pm to 3.20pm the school car parks are out of bounds to families, unless you have a Park Spring Primary Parking Permit. This is to keep everyone safe while coming into and leaving the school grounds.
