If they would like to book a place, please call Tel: 03333 583 397 (option 2 ext 3). You can also call this number to check if your child has already had this in school.

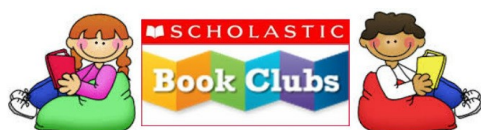
Please note there are limited spaces at this clinic and they will be allocating them on a first come first served basis.

Last week we had a true Park Springer representing our school in the Leeds Cross Country finals at Temple Newsam.

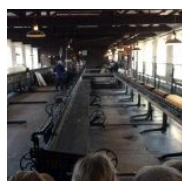

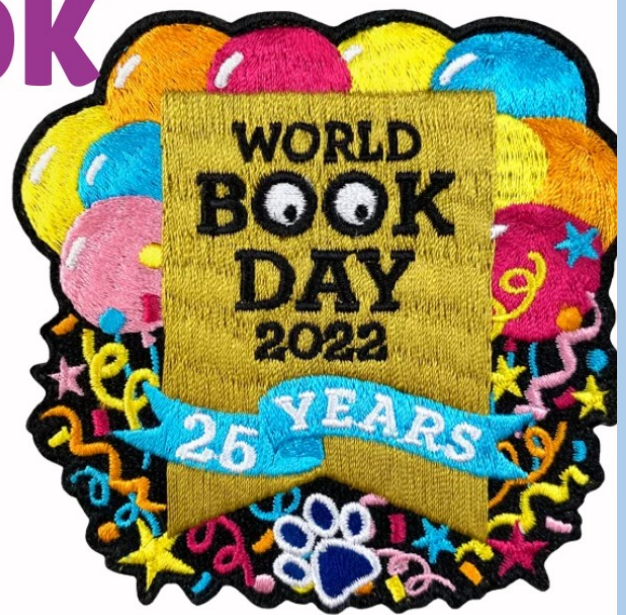
