1	Printmaking has not always been thought of as an art form. It is a method of reproducing images or print that was first used to copy newspapers and books. However artists have also used and refined the technique to produce true artworks.		
2	Rembrandt	Is an artist from the 1600's. He used printing to create a self-portrait and other works.	
3	Katsushika Hokusia	Is a Japanese artist who used printing to make this representation of Mount Fuji.	
4	Andy Warhol	Is an artist from the Pop Art movement in the 60s. He used printing to create multiple identical images in his work.	

Architecture

5	Architecture is the design of buildings, executed by architects. In art it is considered to be the expression of thought in building.		
6	Cuthbert Brodrick	He was one of Leeds's key architects. He designed the Corn Exchange, the City Museum and the Town Hall.	
7	Alex Whitbread	He is a current Leeds architect responsible for many new developments across the city. His most famous so far is the award-winning Broadcasting Place (the 'Rusty Building').	

Techniques

8	viewfinder	A simple device that allows you to isolate or "crop" a scene within a rectangular area.
9	drawing	A form of visual art where a person uses various drawing instruments to mark paper.
10	printing block	Like a homemade stamp made by sticking textured items to a block in the pattern you want to print.
11	one colour print	Only use one colour ink when printing in the same place on the paper.
12	polystyrene print	Like a homemade stamp. You take a polystyrene and carve away every part of the image you want to be white.
13	two colour print	Overlap two colours to create a different effect or to blend the colours.
