School Uniform and PE Uniform

If your child has PE on a specific day of the week they will need to come to school in their PE Uniform (please refer to the uniform policy) and will remain in their PE Uniform for the rest of the school day. PE will be outside so you will need to make sure you are warm. For you reference please see the PE days below. PE Uniform MUST be a **navy blue or black hoodie/zip up jacket, navy blue or black jogging bottoms or leggings and a white t-shirt**. Please note that leggings can only be worn as PE uniform and <u>NOT</u> as everyday uniform

If your child's PE lessons will be taking place on the field your class teachers will be in touch to request that your child brings a pair of trainers to change into for the lesson and obviously one to wear as normal around school and to and from school. The field is very muddy at this time of year, and we are upsetting the cleaning team! If you can send your

child's PE trainers in a named bag this would help avoid loss, keep them all stored safely and be a place to put the muddled footwear back into to return home with.
