Interrelated Dimensions of music

1) Tempo: Speed—fast/slow

2) Pitch: High and low sounds

3) Pulse: The constant beat in a piece of music

4) Dynamics: Loud and quiet

5) Rhythm: Patterns of long and short notes in sound and silence

6) Timbre: The character or quality of a musical sound or voice

7) Structure: How the sections of a piece of music are put together

8) Texture: How layers of sound in a piece of music interact



9) Ostinato: A repeating pattern in music.
