### Late Drop Off and Early Collection from School

We would like to remind all families that it is a legal requirement for children to attend school and that our school day runs from 8.55am to 3.15pm.

Core learning is done in the morning so late drop off disrupts this for not only your child but others in class.

At the end of the school day celebrations of learning are carried out and children who are picked up early miss out on celebrating their achievements with their peers.

### Year 5 and 6 Darts Trip

Thank you to the children who took time out of their Easter break to attend the 'Bullseye Darts Maths' event at the Leeds First Direct Arena. They learnt to use their 2 and 3 times tables to work out doubles and trebles, they added and subtracted to work out scores, they played some darts games, met Joe Cullen (a professional darts player!) and they had a tour of the arena. ### Parking Issues Around School

We have contacted our Neighbourhood Policing Team and our local councillors for advice and assistance in addressing the recent parking issues around school which have been raised previous. It would appear that the situation is not improving.

In the coming weeks you will notice a presence of Police Community Support Officers (PCSO's) who will be issuing on the spot fines for anyone found violating any parking restrictions.
