## Extreme Hot Weather

We have been advised so far that schools MUST remain open during extreme hot weather. With this in mind we would encourage children to come in to school in light weight school uniform (shorts and summer dresses). Please could ALL pupils apply sun cream before school and bring some with them to school to apply themselves and clearly labelled. We would recommend factor 50.

Please can we remind you of the importance of pupils wearing a hat and sunglasses outside.

Water can be kept cooler for longer if it is frozen first. We would recommend that pupils freeze water in bottles that can be re-filled and bring these in to school. Fresh water is available to all students throughout the day. In lunch boxes it may be an idea to freeze other items like yogurts and juice cartons.

As a school we will ensure that all rooms are ventilated properly and in accordance to guidance and will endeavour to keep everyone safe in school.

## Summer Holiday Camps

Leeds City Council is working in partnership this summer with Healthy Holidays and are offering Breeze Healthy Holiday Summer Camps for 8-12 year olds, who are either on free school meals or who are vulnerable and would benefit from a four week camp this summer. The camps will run Monday – Friday 9.00am – 3.00pm from Monday 1<sup>st</sup> August – Friday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2022. The camps will offer a variety of activities including physical activity, arts and crafts, djing/ music workshops, Claymation, den building, giant games, Lego workshops, baking and lots more. The last week of the camps there will be a planned trip to Flamingo Land on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August.

The camps are being funded by Healthy Holidays and will provide breakfast and a healthy meal at lunch as well as being a fun opportunity for children and young people, offering a variety of activities to keep the young people engaged!

All Breeze staff are DBS checked and have the relevant skills and experience to support the camps. Leeds catering will be providing lunches each day and we will provide breakfast and the refreshments. There are thirty places available and we want the places to be filled so that children can benefit from this offer and so that the camps can be successful.
