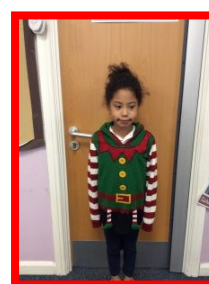
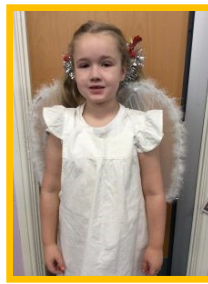
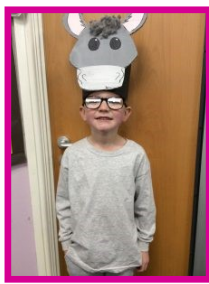
### WHOLE SCHOOL

## PUPPETS FOR JESUS

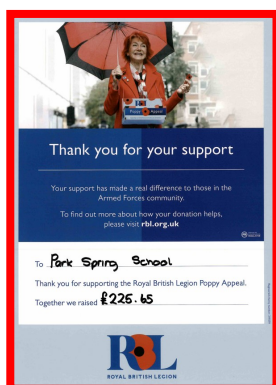

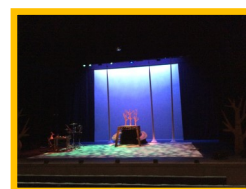
## SCHOOL RECOGNITION ASSEMBLIES
