Region – Lancashire (North West England)

Population - estimated population of 140,000 people

Human Features – Blackpool Tower, Pleasure Beach, Sandcastle Water Park, Blackpool Illuminations, Blackpool Tower Ballroom

Physical Features – Irish Sea, Blackpool Beach, Coast, St Annes Sand dunes

Human Feature – Features of a county that human made.

Physical Feature - Features of a country that are naturally made.

Compass - An instrument which shows the direction of magnetic north.
