

## Artists

1	L.S. Lowry	Lowry painted urban landscapes crowded with people. His work is 'Naïve' because his style is simple.	
2	Sheila Fell	Sheila Fell painted countryside landscapes. Her paintings were often dark and she didn't try to make things look cheerful.	
3	Fun Fact	Lowry bought two of Fells painting at her first exhibition. They were friends for the next 23 years.	


## Colours

4	shade	When you add black to any primary, secondary or tertiary colour it is a shade.
5	tone	When you add grey any primary, secondary or tertiary colour it is a tone.
6	tint	When you add white any primary, secondary or tertiary colour it is a tint.

## Techniques

layering	Adding more layers once paint has dried can create texture and depth in painting.
card stippling	Dipping a small square of card in paint allows you to paint in straight lines.
photography	Taking photos allows artists to continue to work on an observational piece back in their studio. Or to collect ideas to use to inspire their work.

## Media

watercolour	Watercolour can be a block or a tube, you add water to it to create subtle colours.	
acrylic	Acrylic paint is a fast-drying, glue like paint. Acrylic paints become water-resistant when dry.
