

1:10	Registration of Children	The whistle will sound, and all children will be asked to return to their class base. Your child's teacher will take a register However, we will encourage families to stay on the hill side of the field while this is taking place because there is more in store
1:15	Announcement of the Create your Own Crown Competition	In the Sport Pen, there will be a parade of all of the lovely Crown Competition entries and the winners will be announced.
1:20	Its Choir Time	Our Park Spring Choir will perform some lovely songs for families, pupils, and staff to enjoy.
1:30	Announcement of the Bake a Cake Competition	Bake a Cake Competition entries will be celebrated, and the winners will be announced.
1:35	Whole School Song	At the end of all these wonderful celebrations the whole school will sing our School Song.
1:40	Pupils to Return to Class	At the end of all of the celebrations ALL pupils MUST return to class.

If you wish to take your child(ren) home after they have returned to class, we ask that you give us until 1:50 to make sure everyone is in class, and then go to the school office to make your request – ALL CHILDREN LEAVING EARLY MUST BE SIGNED OUT AT THE SCHOOL OFFICE – Please bear with us as this will be a busy period.

For children who attend nursery at the Beginning of the week (Monday to Wednesday AM) you more than welcome to come and join us on the day.

Where adults are not able to attend our garden party, all children will eat together with their class teacher(s) and friends from their class. No-one will be left out of the celebrations!

On the day our wonderful FOPS team will be selling cold drinks and celebration bags of sweets on the playground. Please bring money to the party or if you are unable to attend with your child and would like to give them some money to spend at the stall, please ensure this is put in a clearly labelled and sealed envelope/bag with your child's name and class on.







On Friday 5 May 2023 children and staff will be encouraged to come into school in RED, WHITE AND BLUE clothing, in homage to our patriotic colours of the Great Britain Flag.
