1	Fluffy	Covered in fluff-small light clumps.
2	Shiny	A smooth object that reflects light.
3	Stretchy	Can be pulled to make it longer or wider then returns to its shape.
4	Dull	Does not reflect the light.
5	Rough	Feels bumpy or uneven.
6	Smooth	An even surface free from lumps.

7	Bendy	Folds easily.
8	Non-bendy	Does not fold or bend.
9	Waterproof	Can be pulled to make it longer or wider then returns to its shape.
10	Absorbent	Soaks water up.
11	Transparent	Can see through it.
12	Opaque	Cannot see through it.
13	Translucent	Light can pass through but it can't be seen through clearly
