2	Georgia O'Keefe	She was considered a pioneer in natural art. She painted simplified shapes and forms found in nature.	
3	Andy Goldsworthy	Is an environmentalist and promotes the beauty of nature through photographing sculptures he has made with natural materials.	

Techniques

7	blending/ smudging	Is when you use a finger or rubber to soften lines.	
8	layering	Put colours on top of other colours to create different effects.	
9	viewfinder	A simple device that allows you to isolate or "crop" a scene within a rectangular area.	
10	sculpting	Is the art of making 2D or 3D representative or abstract forms, in a range of media.	
11	photography	When creating art that is not permanent taking a photo of it preserves the image.	

Media

4	chalk pastel	Is an art medium in the form of a stick, consisting of powdered pigment and chalk.	
5	natural media	is a collection of communication techniques that use natural materials like water, sand, stone, leaves, chalk, ice and snow to create images and messages.	
6	clay	Is earth that can be moulded when wet, and is dried and baked to make bricks, pottery, and ceramics.
