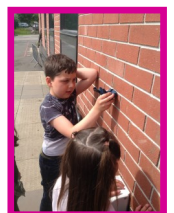
### HALF TERM

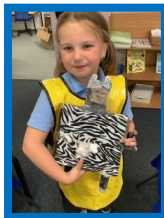
### BREAKFAST AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

Wow! We had so much fun at the school disco last night! Thank you to FOPS for organising it was fantastic!

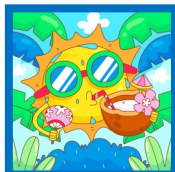
