BREAKFAST AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

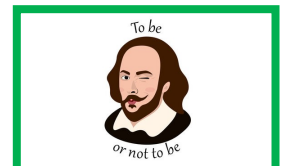
If your child attends our breakfast and after school provision, please can you check your parent pay to make sure all your fees are all up-to-date.
