### 2.4 How can we look after our planet?

Key Concepts		
How Christians believe that the world was created.		Christians (like Jews and Muslims) believe in one God, who created the world and all that is in it. They believe it took God 6 days to make the world and that on the 7 <sup>th</sup> day he rested
How Muslims believe the world was created.		Muslims are the people who follow Islam. They believe in one God who created everything - he is called Allah (the Arabic name for 'God'). If Allah wanted something he just said "let it be."
The world is a special place and we should look after it.		It is important to care for the world that we live in. Christians and Muslims see this as a God-given responsibility. To look after the world we should recycle and reuse things and protect our environment.
