Could you travel around the world in 80 days? - Geography

1) Continent – a large area of land made up of multiple countries

The seven continents of the world are – Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe and Australia.

2) Ocean – a large body of water (larger and deeper than a sea)

The five oceans of the world are - Pacific Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Arctic Ocean, Southern Ocean and Indian Ocean.



3) Australia is the smallest continent in the world.

4) Australia's major cities are Sydney, Canberra, Brisbane, Perth and Melbourne.

5) The Great Barrier Reef - the world's largest coral reef system located in the Coral Sea, off the north-eastern coast of Australia.

6) Physical feature - Features of a country that are naturally made.

7) Human Feature - Features of a county that human made.

8) Atlas – a book of maps.

9) Map - A drawing of an area showing human and physical features.

10) Key - small pictures that show different features on a map.

11) Compass – an object used for finding direction

12) The 4 main compass points are – North, East, South and West
