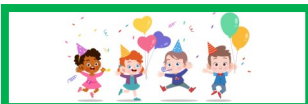

We are now taking bookings for breakfast and after school club provisions. If you need to use any provision please complete the form that is attached to the email sent out with this newsletter.

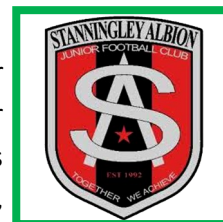
