- 1) Island – a large body of land surrounded by water.
- 2) Mainland – an area joined by other countries/places.
- 3) Country - a defined area of land.
- 4) Rural – an area away from towns and cities.
- 5) Mainland – an area joined by other countries/places.
- 6) Village – a small settlement usually found in a rural setting.
- 7) City – a large settlement where many people live and work.
- 8) Coast- where the sea and the land meet.



8) The United Kingdom is made up of 4 countries – England, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales.

9) The Capital of Scotland is Edinburgh.

10) The Isle of Coll is an Island off the west coast of Scotland.

11) India is a country in Asia.

12) The capital of India is New Delhi.

13) Physical feature - Features of a country that are naturally made.

14) Human Feature - Features of a country that human made.

15) Atlas – a book of maps.

16) Map - A drawing of an area showing human and physical features.

17) Key - small pictures that show different features on a map.

18) Compass – an object used for finding direction
