

- 5) Largest cities of the UK England – London (C), Newcastle Upon-Tyne, Leeds, Manchester, Scotland – Edinburgh (C), Glasgow, Dundee, Aberdeen Wales – Cardiff (C), Swansea, Newport Northern Ireland – Belfast (C), Derry, Lisburn
