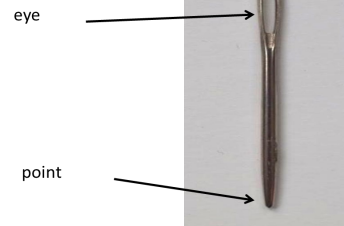
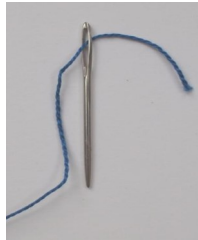

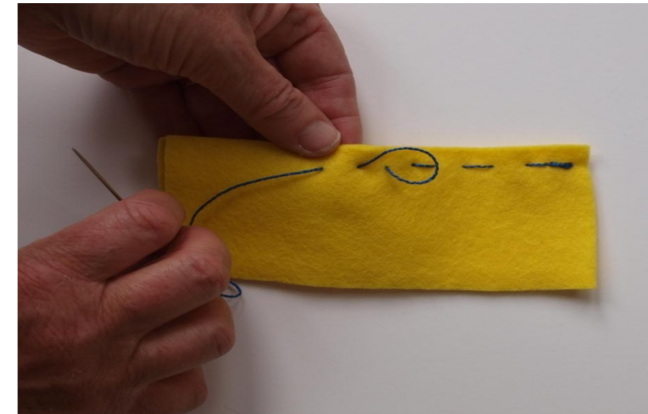
How do we keep our luggage safe when travelling?

1. A **needle** is used to sew pieces of fabric together.
2. The **thread** is pushed through the **eye** of the needle and tied in a knot.
3. Use the pointed end to make small holes in the fabric.

Running Stitch

4. A running stitch is a simple needlework stitch consisting of a line of small even stitches which run back and forth through the cloth without overlapping.

5. To make the luggage tag **appealing decoration** needs to be added.

Ideas for decoration would be:



Buttons



Ribbon



Felt Shapes



Fabric ink

6. To attach appealing decorations you will need **suitable adhesive**.

Ideas of suitable adhesives would be:



PVA glue



Needle and thread

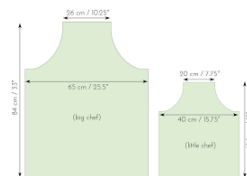


Double sided tape
