

Continuous attendance is so important.

Your child's absence will not be authorised for any of the below:

- Being late after the registers have closed at 9:15am (this is classed as both a late and an unauthorised absence)
- Holidays, leave or travelling in term time.



- Being away from school to care for younger children or sick relatives.
- If a parent is sick, but the child is well enough for school.
- Going shopping, having a haircut or similar leisure activities.
- Where no explanation is offered by the parent or carer or where the school is not satisfied with an explanation offered.
- Special occasions e.g. birthdays/weddings.
- The days surrounding an authorised funeral day.
- Visiting another country for medical treatments.
- Taking the rest of the day off before or after a medical appointment.
- Visiting sick relatives.
- Exceptional term time leave longer than agreed by the Headteacher.



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
#### **NEW LUNCH SYSTEM**


The new system has many advantages and one of which is that you will be able to pre book your child's lunches a term at a time. This will help with planning and save time at the beginning of the school day.

### TRAINING & EVALUATION TIMELINE

- Following initial evaluation tasks in September 2024, the training programme runs over 5 sessions between November 2024 and January 2025.
- Emotion Coaching is used by adults in their everyday interactions with children in the Early Years setting.
- Final evaluation activities take place June 2025.
