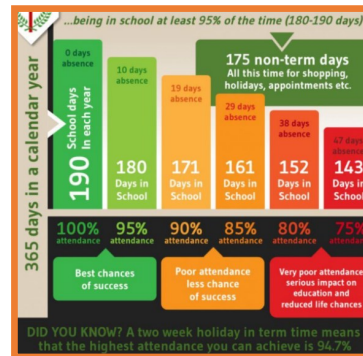

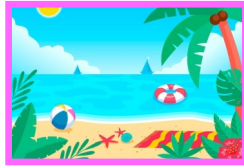
CROCS CAMPAIGN

BE SUMMER READY!

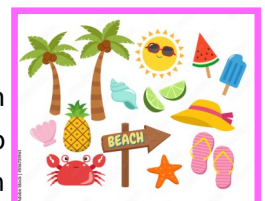
SCHOOL MEALS

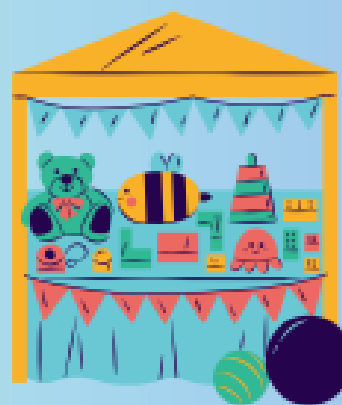

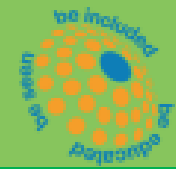
