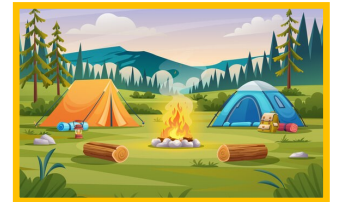

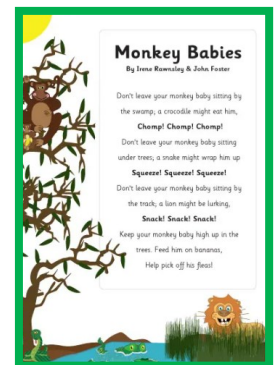
## APPARATUS
