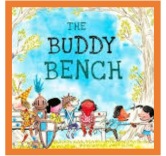

Cianna S, Heidi B and Nicole Z in year 4 have introduced and welcomed lots of our pupils to join them on the Buddy Bench.

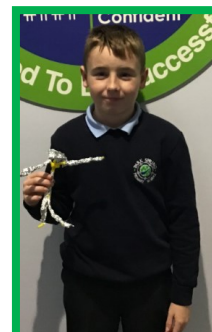
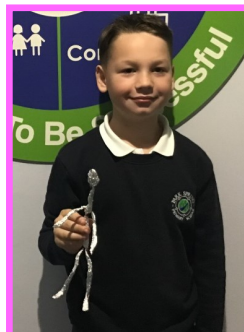
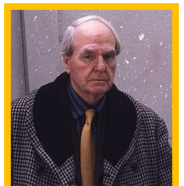
This bench is to promote friendship, reduce loneliness at lunch time and to encourage new friendships.

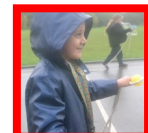

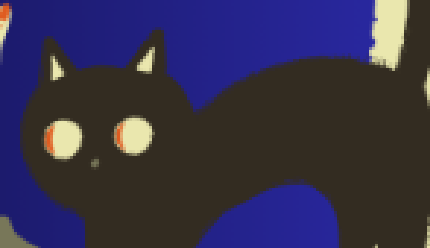
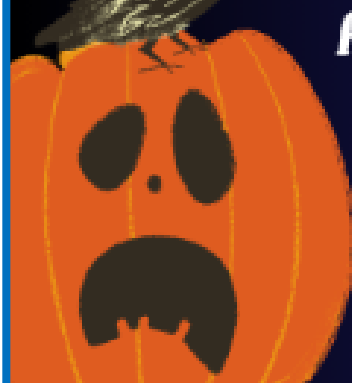
