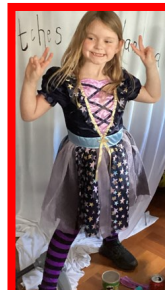
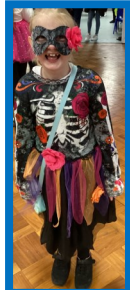
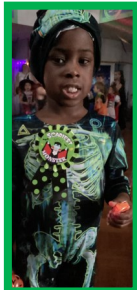
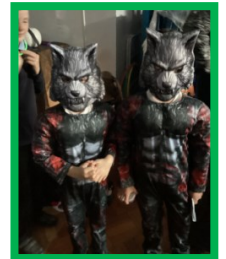
YEAR 2

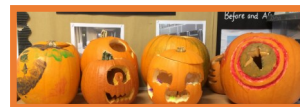
YEAR 5

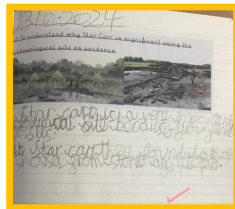
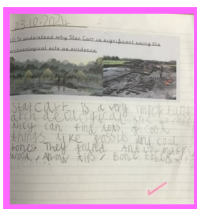
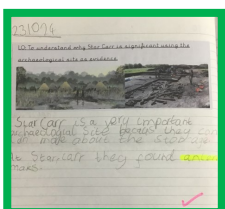
YEAR 1
