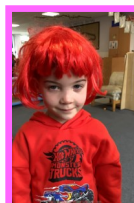


RED NOSE DAY

Thank you to everyone—so far we have raised **£231.00**.





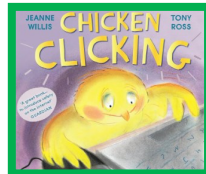
YEAR 6

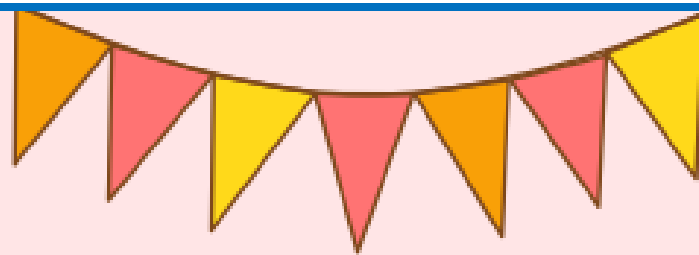

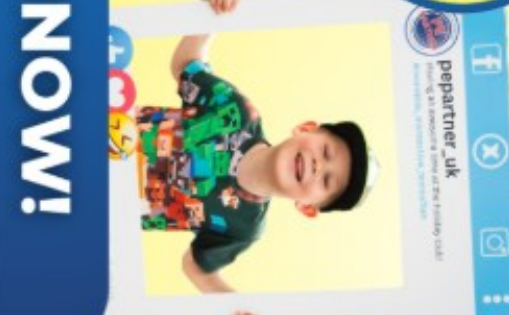
